BY RIDER FOR DONATIONS-ACCEPTANCE OF BEQUESTS AND GIFTS (NJS 40A:5-29)
FOR THE CONDUCTING A COMMUNITY DAY FOR ELSINBORO TOWNSHIP CALLED
ELSINBORO DAY

WHEREAS, permission is required of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services for approval as a dedication by rider of revenues received by a municipality when the revenue is not subject to reasonably accurate estimates in advance; and

WHEREAS, NJS 40A:5-29 provides for receipt of donations from the public by the municipality to provide for the operating costs to administer this act; and,

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-39 provides the dedicated revenues anticipated from the public for the Conducting of a Community Day for Elsinboro Township Called Elsinboro Day are hereby anticipated as revenue and are hereby appropriated for the purpose to which said revenue is dedicated by statute or other legal requirement:
