Administration- Mayor Elwell informed everyone that our Tax Collector will be retiring at the end of April. He also told us the hunting at the old country club property has been addressed, no fire arm hunting but they can bow hunt.

Board of Health – Mayor Elwell informed us that we had 33 dogs and 11 cats At our Rabies clinic that was held on January 28, 2017.

Committeeman Hogate wanted to remind everyone that Ned Shimp will be here every Tuesday in February for dog licenses 6pm -8pm.
