ORDINANCE 2017-03

**Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ELSINBORO,
COUNTY OF SALEM, AND THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY,
APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$8000.00 FOR EMERGENCY
REPAIR TO THE SIDEWALK AND A COPIER.**

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro previously adopted a budget which included a "Capital Improvement Fund"; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2017-25 the members of the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro authorized emergency repairs to the sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, the Township committee will purchase a new copier when this Ordinance is final; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Township Committee have determined that the health, safety and welfare of the Township residents requires that a portion of the money contained in the above-mentioned line item be appropriated for the purpose stated herein below,

NOW, THEREFORE, BEIT ORDAINED by the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro, County of Salem, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- (1) The sum of \$8000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Township's "Capital Improvement Fund", which amount shall be used for the following purpose:
 - a) Emergency repair to municipal building sidewalk and copier in an amount not to exceed \$8,000.00
- (2) The capital budget of the Township of Elsinboro is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith. The resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing in full detail the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.
- (3) This ordinance shall be effective after final passage and publication in accordance with law at a meeting on June 5, 2017
