

Ordinance -2024-10

Title: AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ELSINBORO, COUNTY OF SALEM, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$12,000.00 FROM THE TOWNSHIP OF ELSINBORO'S CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE PURCHASE OF VARIOUS TECHNOLOGY IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro (hereinafter Committee) have determined that the health, safety and welfare of the employees and citizens of the Township of Elsinboro require that numerous capital improvements and capital purchases be made; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and members of the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro, County of Salem, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. There is hereby appropriated from the following sources, the sum of \$12,000.00 to be used for the following Capital Project within the Township of Elsinboro:

2. The purpose described in Section 1 is not a Current Expense and is an improvement, which the Township may lawfully make as a general improvement.
3. The period of usefulness of the purpose described in Section 1 hereof is within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof is five (5) years or more.
4. No debit is authorized by this Ordinance.
5. The Capital Budget of the Township of Elsinboro is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistencies therewith. The resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing in full detail the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.

6. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part thereof.
7. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances heretofore adopted and that are inconsistent with the terms and provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
8. This ordinance shall be effective after the final passage and publication in accordance with the law.

NOTICE

The above ordinance was introduced and passed on first reading at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro on the 2nd day of December, 2024, at the Township Hall, 619 Salem-Ft. Elfsborg Road, Salem, New Jersey, and should be presented for final consideration and passage at a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Elsinboro to be held on the 17th day of December, 2024 at 5:00pm.
